## Surprise task b: Making your own Frisbee from fabric

## What you need:

$\square$ a piece of A3 paper $\quad 2$ pieces of fabric of about $30 \mathrm{~cm}^{2} ■$ compasses
$■$ scissors $\quad$ pins $\quad 80 \mathrm{~cm}$ of lead ribbon $\quad$ a safety pin $■$ thread

- a sewing machine

1 Draw a circle with a diameter of 26 cm on your piece of A3 paper.

2 Cut the circle out.


3 Take the two pieces of fabric. Put them on top of each other, so that the colourful sides face each other.

4 Pin the paper circle onto the fabric.


5 Cut out the circle. Remove the paper circle.

6 Pin the circles of fabric together and tack them.

7 Stitch the two pieces of fabric together about 1 cm from the edge. Leave a small opening.


8 Turn the fabric inside out so that the colourful side is now facing outwards.

9 Tack around the edges.


10 Stitch the fabric about 1 cm from the edge so that you have piping one centimetre wide running around the edge of the fabric. Leave a small opening.

11 Thread the lead ribbon with the help of the safety pin through the piping in the material.


12 Sew the small opening together so that it is closed. Your Frisbee is ready to use!
