

Feeding



Stone martens eat a variety of food from plants and other animals. They feed on birds, birds' eggs, mice, worms, larvae and snails. In autumn, fruit and berries are also on the menu. Stone martens like to *stockpile* food. Eggs are easy to transport to their nests and they also keep for a while. If they live near human settlements, stone martens also search for leftovers in *rubbish* or in pet food bowls left outside. Stone martens are active and hunt at night. They are fast and skilled hunters.
